#### Class of 2019 Summer Workshops

August 20 – 24, 2018

Students will attend **one** of ten 2½-hour sessions to complete the Common Application and learn about our office procedures for the college application process.

This Workshop is mandatory and we ask students and families to schedule vacations and plans around one of these sessions.

## Juniors – Talk to Teachers and Save the Date(s)!

In our final College 101 session, juniors were instructed to approach one teacher for a letter of recommendation to be included in college applications. As of May 1, students were able to ask a second teacher for a recommendation. Please see Haiku for a list of colleges the require more than one teacher recommendation. Once the teacher has agreed to write the letter of recommendation, the College Counselors will do **all** follow-up to ensure its completion prior to the first application deadline.

By now, every junior **should** be registered to take at least one ACT and/or SAT by the end of their junior year. If they have not already created accounts for the ACT (www.actstudent.org) and SAT (www.collegeboard.org) we implore them to do so as soon as possible. For those taking AP exams, a CollegeBoard account is required in order to receive scores in July. Having official test scores will allow students, families, and college counselors to build a well-rounded "list" for our students.

When registering, please use the student's legal name and Bullis email address. If these accounts have already been made (even if a different email address was used) **do not** create another account. Additionally, we encourage students to use the spreadsheet in Haiku or one of their own to save usernames and passwords for these accounts.

For any student who tests with accommodations, please check with Mrs. Anzelone before registering for standardized tests.

The students enter their academic and extracurricular information into the calculator, which using a proprietary formula developed over the past decade, will determine those odds. Admissions Company hopes that this tool will help high school juniors and seniors better plan their application process by choosing colleges based on their odds. Admissions Company also hopes that this tool will help high school freshman and sophomores better plan their academic curricula and activities to aim for the college of their dreams.
