Upcoming AP Exams

It is Advanced Placement time! Below is a schedule of the upcoming AP Exams for standardized testing conditions. ***If you are taking the AP Exams with accommodations, please refer to your emails from Mrs. Anzelone with details for locations and times.*** Students **must** arrive on time and should plan to bring the following items with them to each exam:

1. Several #2 pencils with erasers and/or a separate eraser
2. A pen with black or dark blue ink
3. A drink and a snack (for students with extra time, bring a substantial snack or sandwich)
4. A calculator with fresh batteries (for the exams that require a calculator)
5. A watch (with tones turned off. No smart watches). Some of the rooms have clocks; others do not. Proctors will provide time cues as permitted by the College Board

Summer ACT Boot Camp

Applerouth is pleased to offer its second annual Summer Boot Camp for rising juniors and seniors, which runs from July 27 through August 8. The Boot Camp, which costs \$549 is a two-week, twenty-hour intensive instructional period focusing on major standardized test concepts and strategies. An expert tutor leads the course, using engaging teaching methods to keep material compelling and digestible. Test guides and session notes are provided to help reinforce study and retention. Two mock test opportunities are included with the course and students will receive a detailed results-analysis to help them chart their own unique course towards mastering the ACT.

Reminders for our Juniors



In our final College 101 session, juniors were instructed to approach one teacher for a letter of recommendation to be included in college applications. As of now, students who need a second letter of recommendation are welcome to ask. Please see Haiku (there is a link on the Twelfth Grade page) for a list of colleges requiring more than one teacher recommendation. Once the teacher has agreed to write the letter of recommendation, the College Counselors will do **all** follow-up to ensure its completion prior to the first application deadline.

CollegeBoard

By now, every junior **should** be registered to take at least one ACT and/or SAT by the end of their junior year. If they have not already created accounts for the ACT (www.actstudent.org) and SAT (www.collegeboard.org) we implore them to do so as soon as possible. Having official test scores will allow

students, families, and college counselors to build a well-rounded “list” for our students.

When registering, please use the student’s legal name and Bullis email address. If these accounts have already been made (even if a different email address was used) **do not** create another account. Additionally, we encourage students to use the spreadsheet in Haiku or one of their own to save usernames and passwords for these accounts as we in College Counseling cannot reset these passwords.

For those taking AP exams, a CollegeBoard account is required in order to receive scores in July.

For any student who tests with accommodations, please check with [Mrs. Anzelone](#) before registering for standardized tests.



Additionally, This summer, College Counseling will host its most important session for the Class of 2020.

Throughout the week of **August 19 – 23**, current juniors will attend **one** of ten sessions offered (two sessions offered each day; one in the morning and one in the afternoon) for two and a half hours to get a jumpstart on the application process and complete their Common

Application and Coalition Application. Coaches are aware that this is a requirement for every senior.
