We want to share an audio book resource that supports learning and leads to improved reading comprehension for qualified students. While it is not a replacement for reading, for some students, reading and listening to text simultaneously, can help improve comprehension and retention.

By using Learning Ally, students can create their own library of recorded novels, textbooks and personal reading. While all text and novels are not yet available, Learning Ally has a search feature that enables the user to conveniently locate books. We recommend you use the summer reading list and textbook list your child will receive from your division. This service is accessible on all devices and at all times making it a convenient way for kids to read. We recommend using this tool now as well as for summer reading.
